PURPOSE

To stimulate and encourage string players of all ages
to enjoy chamber music with colleagues, exploring music of all styles.

PARTICIPANTS

- are limited to groups of 2 through 9 players
- may be any age and skill level
- may include students with students, teachers with teachers, and students with teachers, professionals with amateurs, and amateurs with amateurs....
- may be any group with at least one string player who is a member of ASTA-Los Angeles or “coached or sponsored” by an ASTA-Los Angeles member at the time of registration
- may play in more than one group
- may warm-up in another room 20 minutes prior to performance
- may invite audience; the program is free and open to the public
- must provide music stands needed for your group

LITERATURE

- may be classical chamber music or popular music or alternative styles
- must be for equal parts; no solos with piano accompaniment; no concerti
- may include chamber music with piano (such as duet sonatas, trios, quartets, quintets)
- may not include “prepared piano” music
- is limited to 15 minutes maximum (including set-up time)
- may include more than one piece

REGISTRATION

- DEADLINE is January 21, 2012: postmarked by January 21 or before
- fee is \$30 per group, payable to ASTA-LA Section
- Guidelines and Application are available on www.calasta.org, click on “sections,” then “Los Angeles” at the top of the Home Page.
- is limited to the first 20 ensembles who apply, acceptance notified as received or by January 24.
- fees are not refundable after group is accepted
